161 Prepared Speech - Up to 5 mins (Headings permitted on cards)

135a 15 YEARS & UNDER 21 YEARS Entry Fee: \$5.00

Each competitor shall present a programme of 13-15 minutes of a contrasting nature, prepared prose (3 - 4 minutes) which can be read or memorised, poetry & characterisation. The competitor shall introduce the programme and provide a linking commentary.

135b 15 YEARS & UNDER 21 YEARS Entry Fee \$5.00

Each competitor shall give a 3 minute impromptu speech. The topic shall be selected by the Adjudicator with 1 minute preparation time allowed.

Note: Competitors entering Class 135a & 135b, must enter at least two other classes in own age group.

OPEN

149 Impromptu Speech 3 min (2 min preparation) –format dependant on age of competitors.

158 Telling an Improvised Story - Adjudicator to give subject for story

159 Improvisation for 1 or more people. Competitors to improvise a scene by creating dialogue and action on a theme given to them by the Adjudicator.

(May be run in 2 age groups depending on entries.)

160 Amateur Drama Group **ENTRY FEE \$5.00 per entry** Comedy or Dramatic.

NO MORE than 6 in group. Up to 6 mins

162 Conversation Class (format dependant on age of entrants)

163 Poetry Speaking- Poem written by Competitor

Compositions must be performed (not read) by Competitor. Class will be judged both on quality of composition and performance.

- Remember: In order to get the programme completed and out on time, we need your entries by the closing date. So help us to help you. **\$5.00 late entry fee per competitor.**
- **Titles** - Please fill in as many titles as possible on your entry forms. Do not send copies prior to festival.
- **Time limits** are there for a reason. Please do look carefully at these, as marks will be deducted if over time.
